Consultation with women aggrieved on account of various issued relating to NRI marriages and the representatives of the Ministries/Departments concerned with the subject.

26th March 2018, New Delhi: The National Commission for Women has scheduled a Consultation Meeting to discuss issued relating to NRI marriages as revealed from the complaints/representations received by the commission from aggrieved women with the representatives of the Ministries/Departments concerned at 1100 hrs on 27th March, 2018 at National Commission for Women, New Delhi.

The said meeting will be chaired by Ms. Rekha Sharma, Chairperson of National Commission for women. The main issues to be discussed will include:

- i) Issues relating to impounding/revocation of the passports/issuance of Look out Circular, etc. in cases where the requirements for the same had been found to have been fulfilled.
- ii) Issues relating to the processes concerning services of judicial document/summons/warrants/execution of decrees, etc. in respect of cases where requests have been made to the Ministries/Department concerned.

Such initiative is taken after a pattern is observed by the Commission, as the number of complaints received against the NRI's has increased reluctantly in regard to the same subject matter. Also, such initiative is taken to eliminate the gap between the system and the aggrieved citizens of India.

The Commission is inclined towards servicing the aggrieved women with quick redressals and by this consultation meeting, giving them a platform to show cause their concern towards grievance they face while fighting for justice and how conflict between the law of the land is affecting them, though a number of treaty have been in existence between different countries.
