Sir,

I am directed to state that the National Commission for Women (NCW) has taken suo motu cognizance and constituted an Inquiry Committee under Section 8(1), read with Section 10(1) and (4) of the NCW Act, 1990 to inquire into the media report titled "One held for Sarita Vihar gang rape of Odia Woman".

After looking into the facts and circumstances of the present case, the Commission strongly recommends the following:-

- The police should be pro-active in the investigation of the case which should lead to the arrest of the culprits at an early date.
- Trials should be conducted in a fast track court ensuring speedy justice to the victim so that a correct and strong message is sent to society to resist from indulging in such heinous acts in future.
- Some immediate relief to be provided to the victim and her family and take adequate steps should be taken to rehabilitate her and her dependents.
- Immediately compensate the victim, provide her requisite medical facility and psychological counseling.
- All employers, with female workers in night shift, be directed to make all proper arrangements for safe return of their female employees. Because it is responsibility of the employer to ensure safe return of their female employee, particularly during night shifts.
- The employer should, therefore, be brought under investigation and also be directed to compensate the victim immediately.

I am directed to communicate that the State Government is requested to kindly take appropriate action in the matter and kindly intimate the Commission about action taken expeditiously.
